1	Studies of Bronze Age monuments Purpose: To study the monuments of the Bronze Age in Kazakhstan and their significance in the study of socio-political, economic history of Kazakhstan. Content: Analysis of the location and structural features of archaeological sites, including mounds, fences, menhirs, columns and stone sculptures. Drawing up a map of monuments and identifying links with neighboring regions.	LO: 3,4 5
2	The ethnopolitical history of ancient Kazakhstan Purpose: To study ethnopolitical processes in ancient and medieval Kazakhstan. Contents: Ethnic processes, ethnogenesis, tribal unions, socio-economic, political and cultural aspects. The role of the Jochi ulus in the formation of the Kazakh people and the importance of the Kazakh Khanate. Competencies: to analyze ethnopolitical processes, identify the influence of ethnic communities, the importance of tribal unions for the formation of cultural and political contexts of the region. 3	The Civilization of the Great Steppe Purpose: to study the outstanding achievements of the peoples of the Great Steppe, culture and civilization, and their historical significance in world culture. Contents: ancient culture and craft, horsemanship, metallurgy, nomadic lifestyle, "Nomadic civilization", modern methodological problems in the study of steppe culture, myths and stereotypes of Eurocentrism.
