#### «Formation of professional mobility of future choreographers in a higher educational university»

**Research topic:** Formation of professional mobility of future choreographers in a higher educational university.

**Purpose of the study:** development of a methodology and theoretical justification of the formation of professional mobility of future choreographers in a higher educational institution, practical and experimental verification of its effectiveness.

## **Research objectives:**

1. To identify the theoretical foundations of the formation of professional mobility of future choreographers, to clarify the concepts of «professional mobility», «professional mobility of future choreographers».

2. Determination of psychological and pedagogical conditions for the formation of professional mobility of future choreographers.

3. Development of a functional and structural model for the formation of professional mobility of future choreographers.

4. Preparation of a methodology for the formation of professional mobility of future choreographers in a higher educational institution and practical testing of its effectiveness, giving scientific and practical recommendations.

**Research methods:** theoreticalmethods (analysis of philosophical, sociological, psychological, pedagogical and scientific-methodical literature, generalization, comparison, study and analysis of documents related to the research problem); empirical (questionnaire, conversation, pedagogical control, test, experimental work, pedagogical diagnostics, pedagogical modeling); statistical (mathematical and statistical processing of the obtained research results) methods and techniques devoted to the research problem.

The main provisions (proven scientific hypotheses and other conclusions that a renew knowledge) submitted for defense:

1. In determining the theoretical foundations of the formation of professional mobility of future choreographers in higher education, they were guided by systemic, competence-based, personality-oriented, axiological, personality-activity, creative, psychologically-oriented orientation were guided.

Professional mobility is the readiness of a person for professional activity as a future specialist (professional flexibility, professional adaptability, professional business, professional innovation).

Professional mobility of future choreographers is the ability to work in the context of modern changes and innovative processes, solve abnormal tasks, as well as be ready for rapid, flexible, nomadic adaptation to the requirements and needs of society and the labor market.

In the study, professional mobility as a qualitative quality is characterized by the readiness of a specialist to quickly change the current professional tasks and tasks, a place of work and even a profession within the framework of one profession, as well as the ability to quickly master new professions or updates in them that have arisen under the influence of scientific and technological changes.

The formation of professional mobility of future choreographers allows them to adapt to the conditions of change and successfully act, reproducing the content and forms of their work.

2. The psychological and pedagogical conditions for the formation of professional mobility of a future choreographer in a higher educational institution were determined: creating a favorable harmonious psychological climate and creative environment; instilling the ability to reflect on future professional activities; directing them to maintain psychosomatic health; developing positive motivation that develops creative abilities and ensures subjectivity; realizing the pedagogical capabilities of professional (choreographic) disciplines; compiling the content of professional (choreographic) education on the basis of a multifunctional platform, its universalization, improvement; creation of learning conditions in the transfer, integration, transition from one to another of various activity functions; involvement in activities that develop professional and personal potential. These psychological and pedagogical conditions are interrelated, implemented in a complex.

3. The functional-structural model of the formation of professional mobility of future choreographers as a system includes blocks (conceptual, technological, productive); (target-motivational, content-cognitive, emotional-value. components socialcommunicative); criteria and indicators (the presence of a motivational-necessary attitude to professional mobility; flexible knowledge and skills in the field of choreography; emotional and psychological readiness for changes in professional activity; the presence of communicative and behavioral qualities (reproductive/low, adaptive/medium, creative/high) that allow for rapid adaptation to changes in society, movement and successful action.

4. The methodology for the formation of professional mobility of future choreographers in a higher educational institution consists of three parts: the program of the elective course «professional mobility in choreography», 90 credits, «propaedeutic tasks» and «conditions for the formation of professional mobility» and experimental results showing the effectiveness of this methodology.

**Description of the main results of the study:** it is characterized by a comprehensive analysis of the philosophical, psychological, pedagogical and educational-methodical literature on the research topic; the results of the study are based on methodological bases and have a well-defined theoretical sequence; the use of a complex of scientific and pedagogical methods in accordance with the tasks of the research stages and complementing each other; the effectiveness of the methodology for the formation of professional mobility of future choreographers is tested and proven in the course of a pedagogical experiment.

Justification of the novelty and significance of the results obtained, compliance with the directions of development of science or state programs:

The University developed a methodology for the formation of professional mobility of future choreographers, tested its effectiveness in practice:

- The program of the elective course «professional mobility in choreography» was developed and submitted to the elective component of the curriculum;

- Propaedeutic tasks and situations that form the professional mobility of future choreographers have been prepared.

The results obtained during the study can be used in the process of training choreographers in higher educational institutions of pedagogical and cultural orientation, in advanced training and retraining courses for choreographers.

# Scientific novelty and theoretical significance of the study

1. The theoretical foundations of the formation of professional mobility of future choreographers were identified, the concepts of «professional mobility», «professional mobility of future choreographers» were clarified.

2. Psychological and pedagogical conditions for the formation of professional mobility of future choreographers have been determined.

3. A functional and structural model for the formation of professional mobility of future choreographers has been developed.

4. At the University, a methodology for the formation of professional mobility of future choreographers was developed and its effectiveness was experimentally tested, scientific and practical recommendations were given.
