

PRESENTATION OF THE BOOK "HO CHI MINH" AT ABAI KAZNPU (VIETNAM)

On 3 May, 2017 at Abai KazNPU was held a presentation of the book "Ho Chi Minh" (Vietnam), telling about the life and activities of the Vietnamese political leader, the founder of the Vietnamese Socialist Republic Ho Chi Minh.
