1. The purpose and objectives of the educational program in the major 5B010300- Pedagogy and psychology

2.1 The general cultural competences are characterized by the fact that a graduate:

- 2.2.9 *knows* the ways of organizing professional activity in multicultural society taking into account peculiarities of socio-cultural structure of the society;
- 2.2.10 *is able to participate* in interdisciplinary and interdepartmental cooperation of the specialists for solving professional problems;
- 2.2.11 *can apply* health-protective technologies to his/her professional activity taking into account risks and danger of the social environment and educational space.
- 2.2.12 proficient in critical thinking;
- 2.2.13 shares the values and beliefs of inclusive education;
- 2.2.14 Capable of learning, result-oriented and mobility that will help students develop competencies necessary for them to adapt to a changing labor-market, and that will enable them to become active and responsible citizens.
