During the seminar a wide range of issues related to the creativity of the Kazakh philosopher, poet and composer Abai Kunanbayev will be discussed. A complex of scientific and cultural events of the Center for Kazakh Culture and Science, dedicated to the 175th anniversary of Abai will be carried out. Key issues of the seminar:

- Abai in the world literary context;
- World reception of Abai's creativity;
- The role of Abai in the development of culture and science of Kazakhstan;

- Abai in the modern cultural and information space;
- Ontological issuers in Abai's creativity;
- Abai and the problem of European integration of nomadic peoples;
- Abai's personality and creativity in the context of current philosophy issuers of the modern world;
- Abai's "Words of edification": poetics and reception.

The subject of reports **could be expanded** and is not limited by issuers suggested above. The main goal is to find answers to various interdisciplinary questions related to the relevance of Abai Kunanbayev's ideas.

The registration fee is not provided. Travel expenses will be covered by the participants. The organizers provide with free accommodation in a hotel-type hostel, as well as lunch and a coffee break on the first day of the seminar. The Organizing Committee is ready to provide information support on transfer from Warsaw to Słupsk. Meeting of participants at the station in Słupsk is also possible.

A certificate to participants of a scientific seminar will be provided. The publication of materials is not planned.
